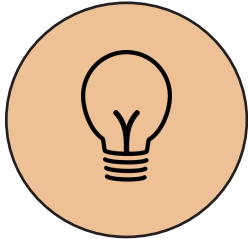

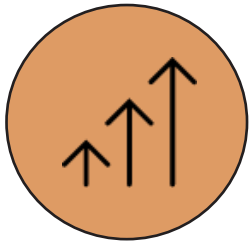

Opportunity

The Reno-Sparks metropolitan area, or Truckee Meadows, has a population of more than 500,000 people. The city proper has a population density of 2,186 people per square mile, or 844 people per square kilometer.



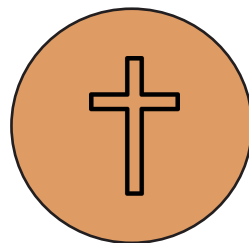
Growth

Around 50,000 people are expected to arrive to the area in the next five years, according to the Nevada Association of Realtors. With the projected population growth, an additional 9,000 homes per year are needed in Reno, according to Economic Development Authority of Western Nevada (EDAWN) – a local agency that forecasts region's economic outlook. These are families we have the capacity to reach.



Our Presence Is Needed

According to Sperling's Crime Rate, Reno's violent crime, on a scale from 1 (low crime) to 100, is 44. Violent crime is composed of four offenses: murder and nonnegligent manslaughter, forcible rape, robbery, and aggravated assault. The US average is 41.4. Nevada also has the highest percentage of divorced people in the country. 13.9 percent of Nevadans over 15 have been divorced, or about 30,000 people. The average in the United States is 10.8 percent. We have the ability to mend broken citizens and homes with our mission.

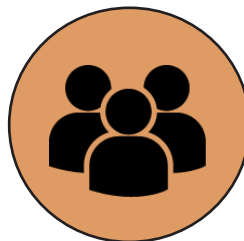
A freshly formed campus challenges us to think “outside the box” in terms of remaining relevant, relational, and engaging in today’s changing culture.

Weekend Worship Experience

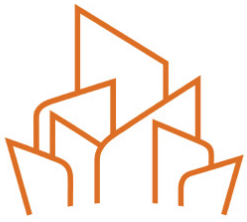

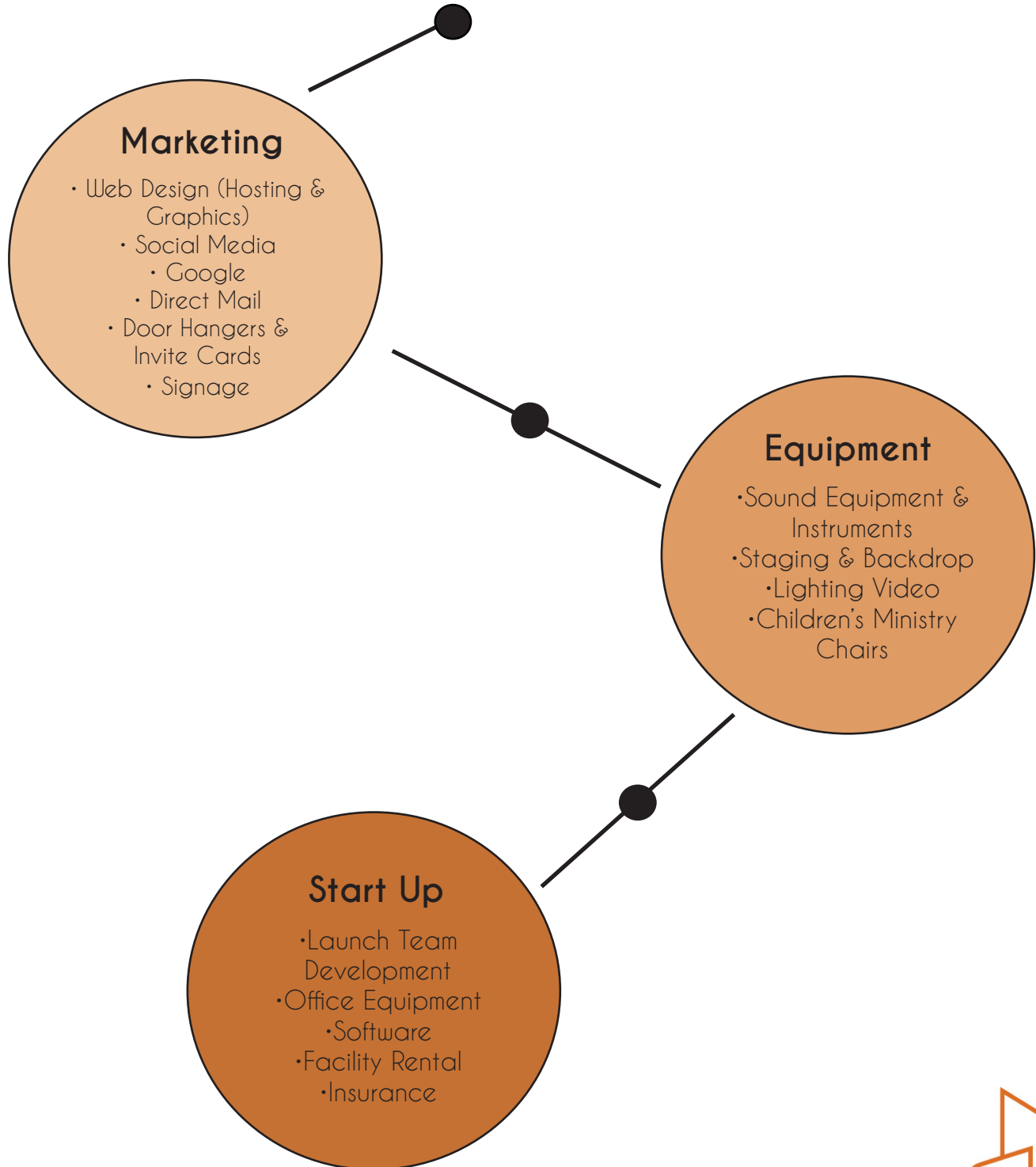


Reaching Beyond Ourselves

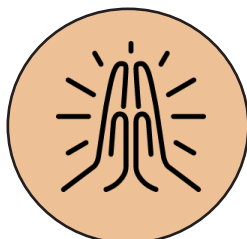
THE COST

HOW YOU CAN HELP



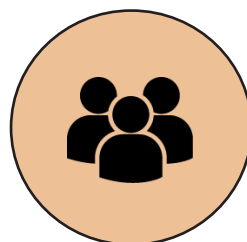
Pray
